

# THE NORTHUMBERLAND REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE

May 11, 2026 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

When all the checks are written for the awarded scholarships, the new balance will be: \$950.50.

The total balance is: \$25,301.55.

Colleen Heanue was our visitor and speaker for the evening. She is the director of the Northern Neck Chapter of the Turning Point USA which meets at the Light of Christ Anglican Church on Thursday evenings at 6: 30 pm.

The membership application of Tom Jeffries was approved. He is the Secretary of the Northern Neck Patriots which will next meet at the Northern Neck Baptist Church on June 2 at 6:30 pm. He was out of town and unable to attend the meeting.

The membership of Trish Piscopo was approved. She was unable to attend due to illness. Colleen Heanue of TPUSA was also approved as a new member.

The Chairman reported on what worked and what didn't re the April referendum. The radio coverage for our area was good however, the placement of our information in the Rappahannock Record buried in such a way as to be of little notice. Our best coverage was done by the Northern Neck Sentinel. We could have used more signs. It was felt that the shorter and more to the point messages are easier to read from the road.
