

NCRC July 8, 2026 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The invocation was read, the pledge recited and the Republican creed read. A quorum was established.

The June minutes were approved.

The June treasurer report was as follows:

As of June 30, 2026 the balance was \$27,237.24.

Operating Account: \$12,213.32

Federal Account: \$12,011.67

Scholarship Account: \$1,900.50

(one scholarship not paid)

Total balance for the accounts as of June 30, 2026 is: \$26,056.49.

Patrick O'Brien asked if the group felt we should man the voting booth on the August 4 primary since our only candidate is Rob Wittman. After some discussion, it was decided not to man the booth on August 4, 2026. We were all encouraged to vote early. A motion was made, seconded by Maurice and it passed unanimously.

With regard to the referenda campaign; i.e.; abortion, gay marriage, automatic felon voting rights, there was considerable discussion. The result was that we voted to object to all the proposed amendments. We voted no on the gay marriage proposal as well as no to restoring felon voting rights on release.

Vice Chairman Report:

Jr. Fisher announced that a meeting of the Board of Supervisors would be held tomorrow evening. Those who cannot attend in person can join via Zoom. He said that the issue of the Chesapeake Bay Protection Act would be raised. He expressed frustration that people harbor so many misconceptions

about the positions of the Board. He encouraged people to attend the meeting.

Discussion of website improvements was held. Maurice has made many of them. The website name is: NCRC-GOP.com.

With regard to updates on the Oyster Roast, the Chairman was not present. It was noted that Mike Baughan has offered to play, but he needs to be notified of such. The discussion on the Roast was tabled until next month.

New Business:

Jr. said he would check on the signs and report back next month.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
