

NCRC Minutes of August 12, 2026

Operating Account: as of 7/31/26 has a balance of: \$11,489.24.

Federal Account: as of 7/31/26 has a balance of: \$12,013.88.

Scholarship Account as of 7/31/26 has a balance of: \$1900.00.

There is still one outstanding scholarship not paid.

Total balance for the 3 accounts is: \$25,403.62.

The Treasurer Report was approved as read.

The July Minutes were approved.
